

DOUBLE CROCHET HAT AND SCARF SET



Skill Level: BEGINNER

Materials:

At least 100 g of Worsted Weight yarn or yarn of your choice.

Size I-9 (5.5 mm) Crochet Hook

Large eye blunt point needle

HAT

Chain 4, slip stitch in 4th chain from hook to form ring.

Round 1: Ch 3, 11 double crochet into ring. Place marker in last stitch to mark end of round. Move marker at end of each round.

Round 2: 2 double crochet in top of chain 3, 2 double crochet in each stitch around – 24 double crochet. Don't forget to move the marker to the last stitch.

Round 3: (2 double crochet in the next stitch, 1 double crochet in the next stitch) 12 times – 36 double crochet.

Round 4: (2 double crochet in the next stitch, 1 double crochet in each of the next 2 stitches) 12 times – 48 double crochet. Remove marker.

Round 5: (2 double crochet in the next stitch, 1 double crochet in each of the next 4 stitches) 12 times – 60 double crochet.

Continue increasing in this manner until circumference matches your head measurement.

Remove marker, double crochet in each stitch until hat is desired length.

Finishing: Half double crochet in the next stitch, single crochet in the next stitch, slip stitch in the next stitch. Fasten off, weave in ends.

SCARF

Chain 17

Row 1: Double crochet in the 4th chain from the hook and each chain across – 15 stitches. For straight edges, count the stitches on every row.

Row 2: Chain 3, skip the last double crochet of the last row, double crochet in each stitch across and in the top of the chain at the beginning of the last row. – 15 stitches – DON'T FORGET TO COUNT!!

Repeat Row 2 until scarf is desired length, ending at the end of a row. Fasten off, weave in ends.
