

DOUBLE CROCHET HAT AND SCARF SET



Skill Level: BEGINNER

Materials:

At least 100 g of Worsted Weight yarn or yarn of your choice.
Size I-9 (5.5 mm) Crochet Hook or hook to match yarn size.
Large eye blunt point needle

Size: Measure the circumference of your head _____.
Divide that number by 3.14. _____ = Diameter.

HAT

Chain 4, slip stitch in 4th chain from hook to form ring.

Round 1: Chain 3 (counts as double crochet here and throughout), 11 double crochet into ring, slip stitch in top of chain 3 to join – 12 stitches.

Round 2: Chain 3, double crochet in same stitch as join, 2 double crochet in each stitch around, slip stitch in top of chain 3 to join – 24 stitches.

Round 3: Chain 3, 2 double crochet in the next stitch, (1 double crochet in the next stitch, 2 double crochet in the next stitch) 11 times, slip stitch in top of chain 3 to join – 36 stitches.

Round 4: Chain 3, 1 double crochet in the next stitch (2 double crochet in the next stitch, 1 double crochet in each of the next 2 stitches) 11 times, slip stitch in top of chain 3 to join – 48 stitches.

Round 5: Chain 3, 1 double crochet in each of the next 2 stitches (2 double crochet in the next stitch, 1 double crochet in each of the next 3 stitches) 11 times, slip stitch in top of chain 3 to join – 60 stitches.

Continue increasing in this manner until the diameter matches your size calculations.

Next Round: Chain 3, double crochet in each stitch around, slip stitch in top of chain 3 to join. Repeat this round until hat is desired length. Fasten off, weave in ends.

SCARF

Chain 17

Row 1: Double crochet in the 4th chain from the hook and each chain across – 15 stitches. For straight edges, count the stitches on every row.

Row 2: Chain 3, skip the last double crochet of the last row, double crochet in each stitch across and in the top of the chain at the beginning of the last row. – 15 stitches – DON'T FORGET TO COUNT!!

Repeat Row 2 until scarf is desired length, ending at the end of a row. Fasten off, weave in ends.
